### **Summary of Award Activity**

During this year's annual Sigma Pi Sigma Induction Ceremony, we invited Sigma Pi Sigma alumni to attend the ceremony and to talk with the new inductees, undergraduate physics majors, and family members in attendance. We were able to use this award to welcome this year's 15 new Sigma Pi Sigma members with a larger induction ceremony which included a dinner with local Sigma Pi Sigma alumni from UMD's graduate student and physics faculty community.

## Statement of Activity

#### Overview of Award Activity

This project was an induction ceremony which introduced new Sigma Pi Sigma members to Sigma Pi Sigma alumni in the local community at UMD. By inviting alumni to attend the ceremony and to talk with the new inductees afterwards over dinner, we were able to accomplish our goal of fostering new relationships between Sigma Pi Sigma members and alumni. 15 members of the target audience for this activity, new Sigma Pi Sigma members, attended this year's induction ceremony. 3 Sigma Pi Sigma members contributed to the success of this project by organizing it and volunteering their time to help set up the ceremony, and because of their hard work along with the efforts of our SPS chapter advisor Donna Hammer, the event was straightforward to accomplish.

#### Impact Assement: How the Project/Activity/Event Met the Purpose of the Award

Even though the networking opportunities that are available to members of such a large and selective organization as Sigma Pi Sigma are discussed at every induction ceremony, many members never take advantage of them. This induction ceremony was an effort to make it clear to every new inductee this year how valuable and important these opportunities are by allowing them to interact and learn from Sigma Pi Sigma alumni in attendance. By inviting Sigma Pi Sigma alumni from the graduate student and faculty community at UMD, we were able to build community among local alumni and new Sigma Pi Sigma members.
